12 May 2021 (Wednesday)

Session 1: Imagining 2050 | 10:00-11:30am Dominican Republic

This session will illustrate a vision for a sustainable, accessible, low carbon passenger and freight transport system in Latin America and the Caribbean by 2050, and share regional support mechanisms to help achieve this vision.

Session 2: Policies for behaviour change and technology development | 11:30am-13:00pm

This session will outline policies and strategies that cities and countries in the region have put in place to lower transport emissions and improve accessibility, while cleaning the air and achieving greater energy independence. Case studies using the *Avoid-Shift-Improve* framework will be shared.

Session 3: Finance and Business Transformation | 13:00-14:00pm

This session will outline opportunities for financing as well as ongoing efforts in the region that are putting the transport sector on a path towards decarbonisation while also contributing to a green COVID-19 recovery.
